## Talking points for SB 33 and SB 65

## SB 33 Funds for Training on Cerebral Palsy Risk in Children:

- Funds will support training for early childhood healthcare workers on early detection of risk for cerebral palsy
- Lowering detection age helps young children benefit from the best evidence-based interventions early in life, when long-term benefits are highest (2010 Cerebral Palsy Foundation)
- Improve continuity of care

## SB 65 Brain Injury Study Funds: SB 109 Brain Injury Services Funds:

- Supports funds to collect data on those who have acquired a brain injury
- Ensure adequacy of existing state resources for people who have acquired a brain injury to increase an individual's independence.
- Will help maintain existing services and potentially develop and fund additional services in the state including rural areas
